The doctoral center "REDIG" enables candidates to pursue a doctorate at Hof University of Applied Sciences. The supervision arrangements are organised in a transparent manner. The professorial members of the participating universities of applied sciences are listed on the website and work together within the REDIG Doctoral College. 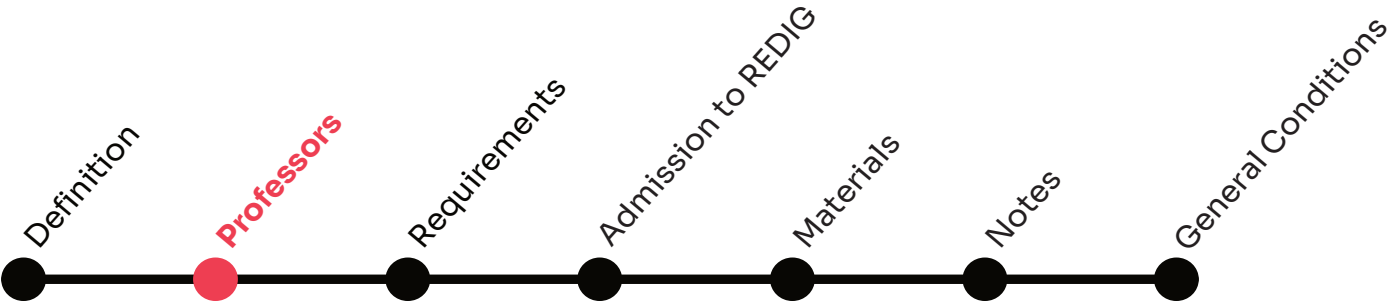

What are the formal admission requirements for the Doctoral Center?

2

Minimum grade of 2.0 in a Master's degree or an equivalent qualification, e.g. a Diplom degree



first supervisor must be a member of the REDIG Doctoral Center



signed supervision agreement

Which documents are required for admission?

- _ a completed and signed Supervision Agreement, including details of all supervisors
- _ research proposal
- _ curriculum vitae and educational background
- _ copy of the higher education entrance qualification
- _ degree certificates for completed higher education programmes
- _ proof of sufficient proficiency in German or English
-> for international applicants



How does the admission process to the Doctoral

1

Clarify your interest in pursuing a doctorate

- _ identify your own research interests and research area
- _ check whether your proposed topic aligns with the profile of the doctoral center

Develop an initial research topic

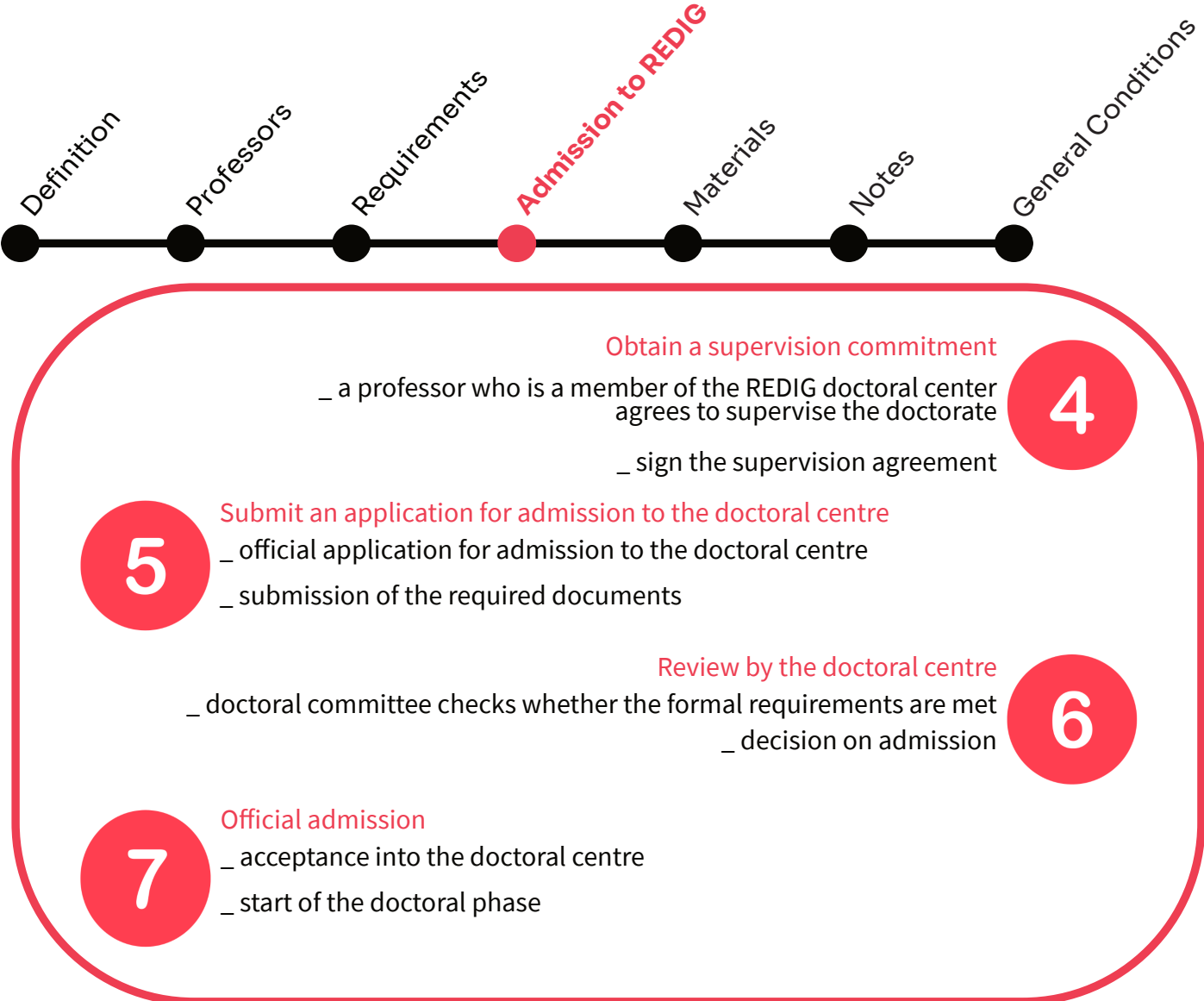
- _ formulate initial ideas for a doctoral research project
- _ prepare a brief concept note or research proposal, if applicable

- _ get in touch and discuss your proposed doctoral project



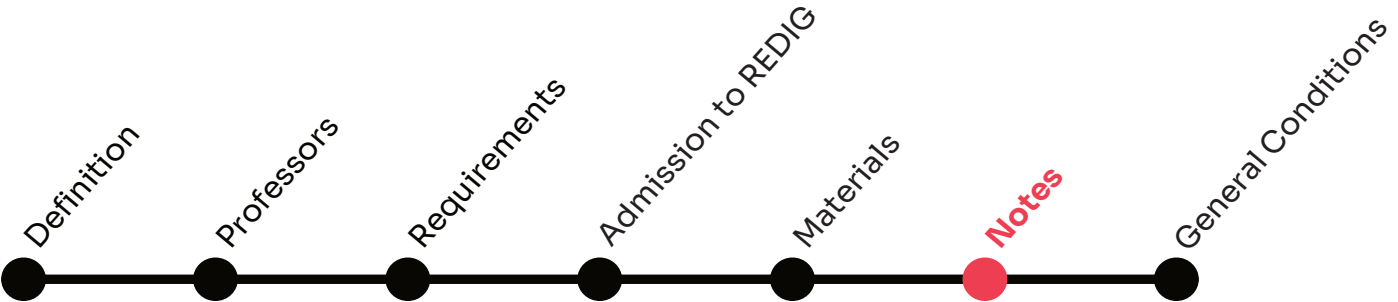

Duration of the doctorate

- _ should not exceed five years
- _ may be extended in exceptional circumstances

Continuing Professional Development Programme

- _ attendance is mandatory
- _ offered in English
- _ worth 30 ECTS credits

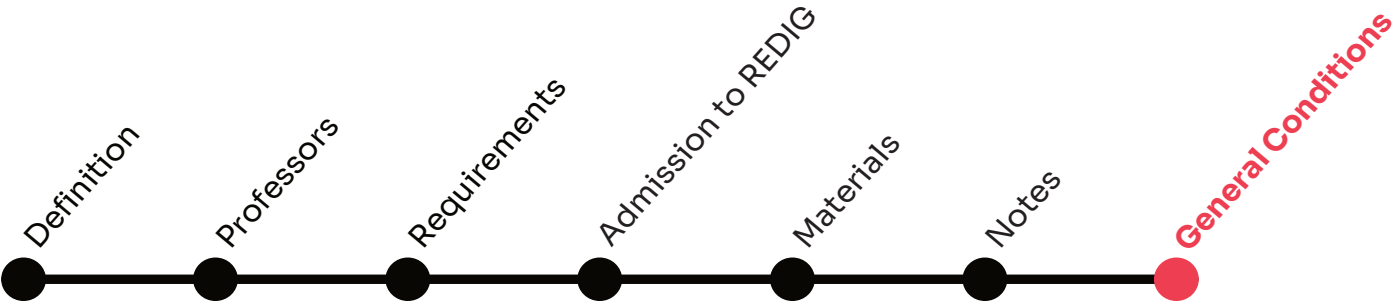
Language of the dissertation

- _ German **or**
- _ English
- _ to be specified individually in the supervision agreement

Supervision and feedback meetings

- _ organised regularly by PhD students
- _ consultations at intervals of no more than 3 months

What is the doctoral process at the REDIG Doctoral Center?



Opportunities

- _ structured supervision by professors from several universities of applied sciences
- _ clear processes
- _ defined deadlines
- _ organisational support
- _ structured qualification programme
- _ access to resources at all participating universities (e.g. libraries)

General Conditions

- _ topics must align with the doctoral centre's focus area
- _ limited number of places
- _ reduced individual flexibility
