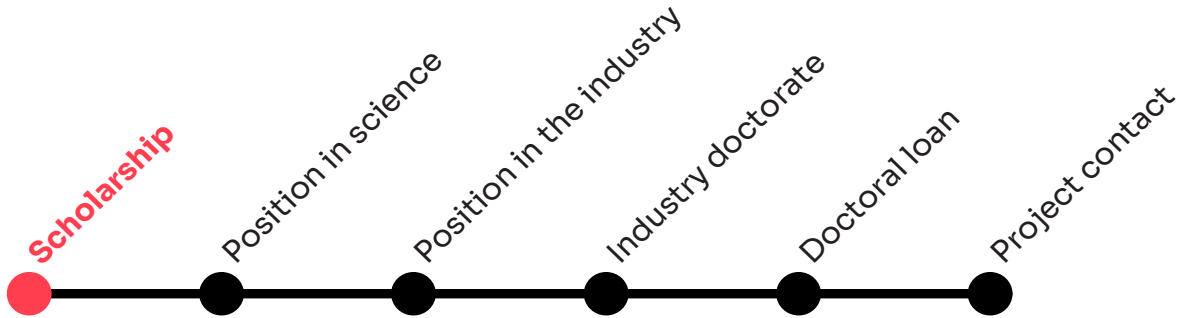


Stop Financing

Scholarship

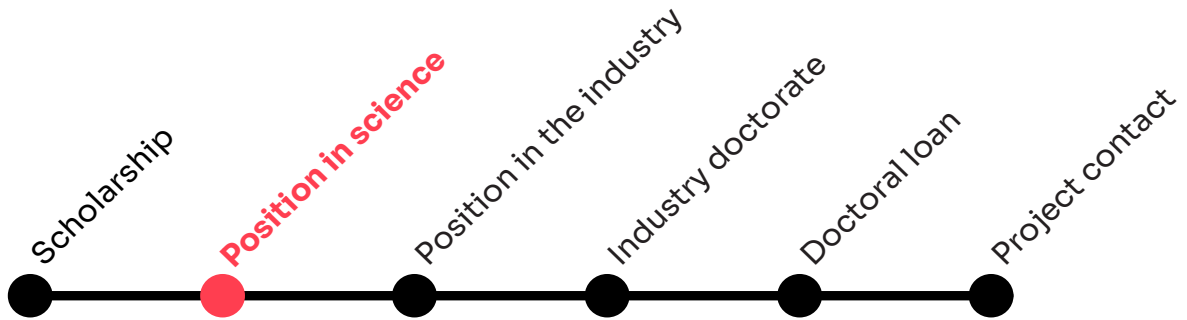
- _ scholarships offer financial support, which is divided into monthly, idealistic and one time funding
- _ work on a research project
- _ designing your doctorate according to your own academic interests

+ advantages

- _ focus on research without having to worry about a source of income
- _ access to additional resources and networks

- disadvantages

- _ hohe Beschränkungen bei einer Nebentätigkeit



Position in science

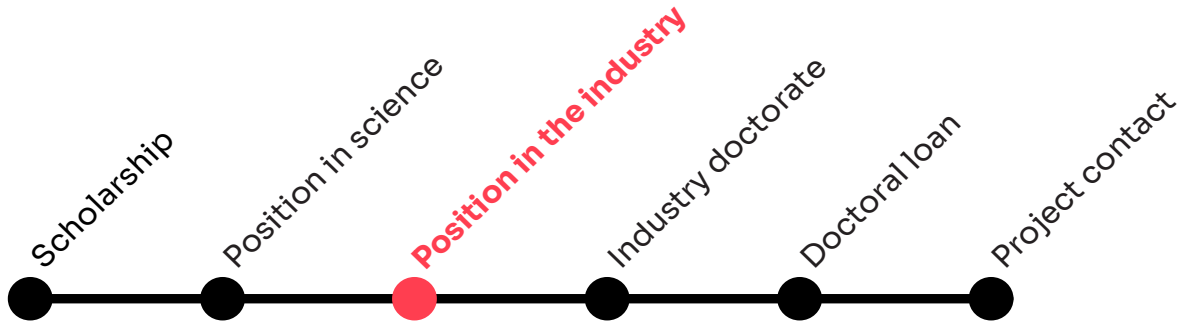
- _ work as a research assistant at a university or university of applied sciences
- _ work on a research project with subject-relevant topics within one's own field
- _ opportunity to gain a broad range of experience and knowledge

+ advantages

- _ close connection between the research topics and the PhD possible
- _ network building and practical experience in research

- disadvantages

- _ fixed-term contracts
- _ project-dependent research topics



Position in the industry

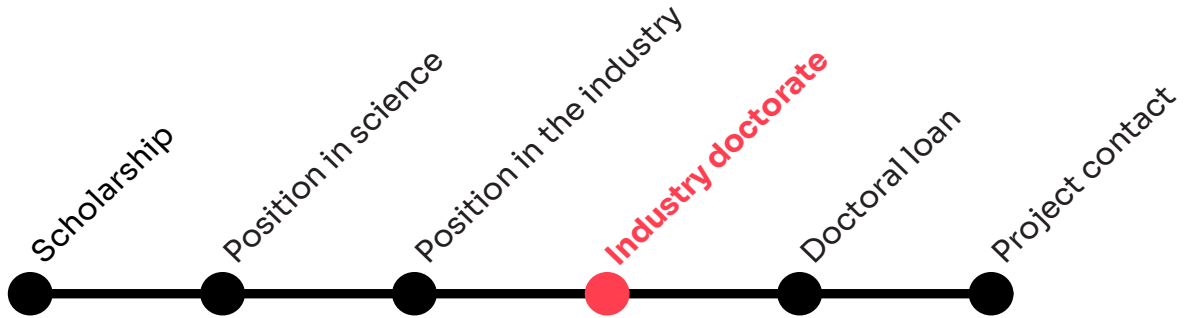
- _ full-time or part-time employment possible
- _ doctorate is pursued in addition to main occupation
- _ doctorate and living expenses are fully financed by employment

+ advantages

- _ financial security
- _ professional experience in practice

- disadvantages

- _ higher workload
- _ lack of time to work on the doctorate results in slow progress



Industry doctorate

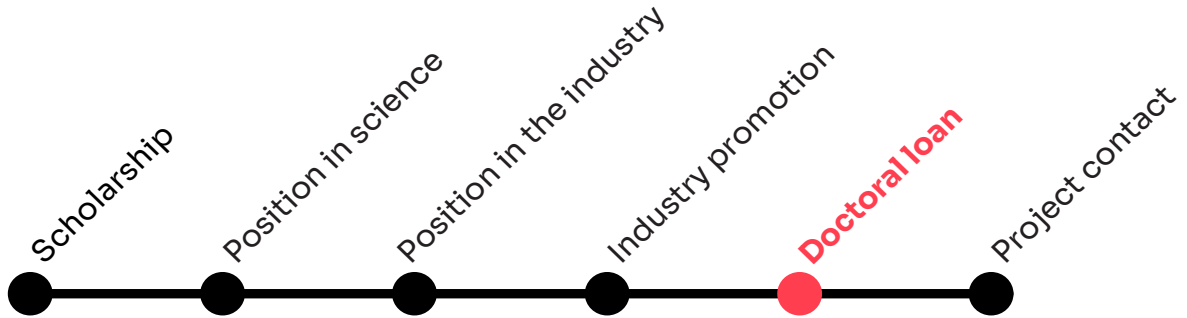
- _ link between academic research and industrial application
- _ doctorate is carried out within the framework of an employment relationship with a company
- _ research is conducted on a practical problem posed by the company, which provides financial resources and support

+ advantages

- _ professional experience in industry and career prospects within the company
- _ intensive supervision by experts and specialist departments

- disadvantages

- _ dependent research topics and possible restrictions on publications
- _ conflicts between research and business interests



Doctoral loan or doctoral funds

- _ doctoral loans: low-interest or interest-free loans, which must be repaid after completion of the doctorate
- _ doctoral funds: one-time grants or regular payments, which generally do not have to be repaid

+ advantages

- _ focus on research without immediate financial burden
- _ support by financing research costs and materials

- disadvantages

- _ financial burden after completion of the doctorate in case of repayment
