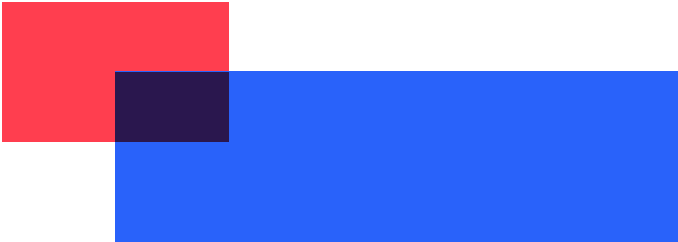
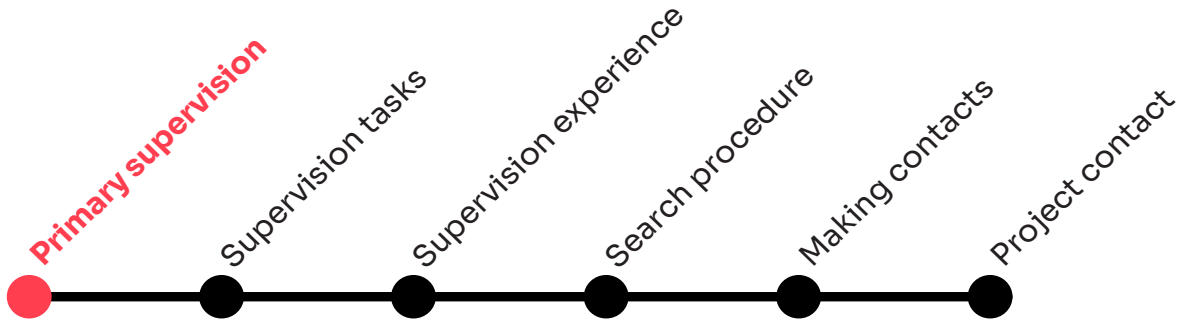


Stop Uni Supervision

While university supervisors usually take on a more overarching, formal role of supervision and later assess the dissertation, the actual content-related and continuous supervision often lies with the supervisor at the University of Applied Sciences (HAW). This close collaboration requires careful selection, as it entails a certain relationship of dependency and contributes significantly to the success of the doctorate.



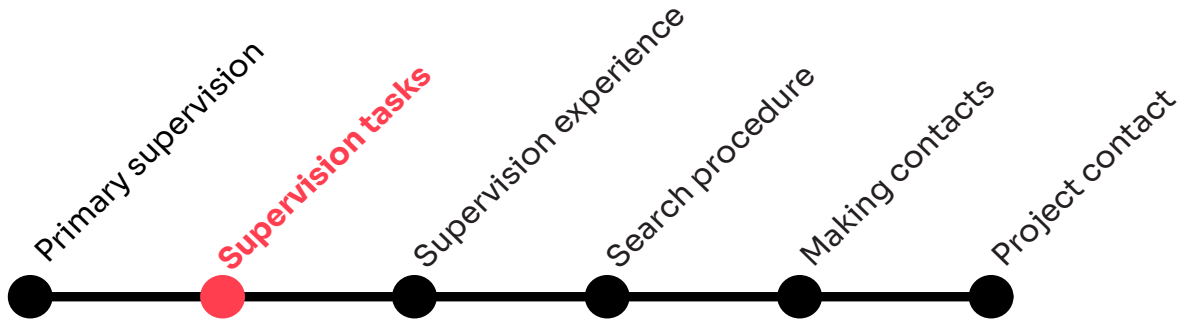
How do I find a supervisor at the university?



Role of primary supervision

In Germany, people are allowed to take on the initial supervision of a doctorate, if they are:

- ✓ a professor at a university.
- ✓ a professor at a university of applied sciences with the right to award doctorates.
- ✓ an emeritus professor with the right to award doctorates.
- ✓ a private lecturer with habilitation.
- ✓ an adjunct professor at a university – these are individuals who have been awarded the title of professor honorarily or upon application, without holding a regular (tenured) professorship.
- ✓ a junior professor at a university.



Supervision tasks

- _ advice and supervision of the doctoral candidate
- _ final review of the dissertation in second marking

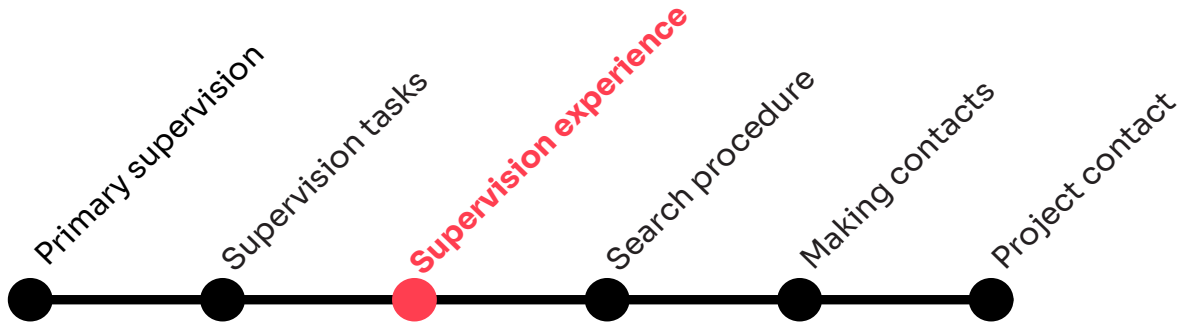
Our tip

- _ interest in the doctoral topic
- _ additional publications
- _ acquisition of third-party funded projects by the doctoral candidate's company



Supervision experience

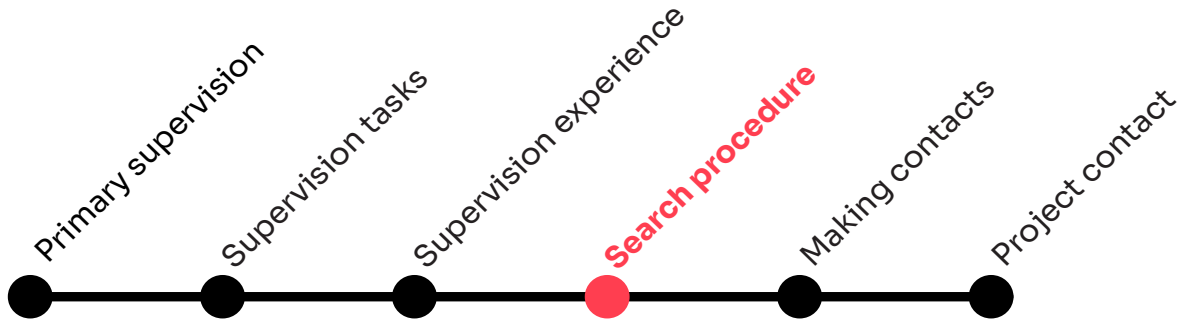
What should the supervisor bring?

- _ professional qualification
- _ reliability
- _ enthusiasm for supervision
- _ a supervisory style that suits the own personality
- _ sympathy
- _ awareness of expectations



But: Supervisors are only human too - with their own individual strengths and weaknesses. At the same time, every doctoral candidate brings their own expectations and needs to the supervisors.

How do I find a supervisor at the university?



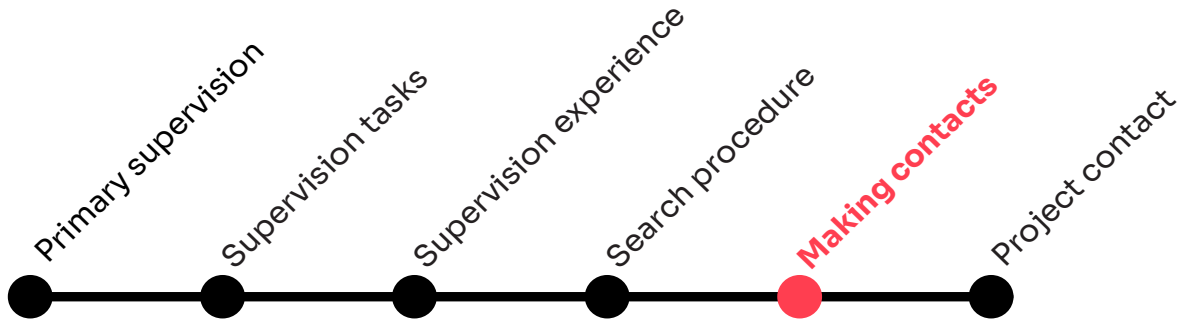
Search procedure

Contacting people at the university who are doing research in the subject area or have expertise in the subject area through

- _ searching university websites
- _ attending specialist conferences
- _ reading publications
- _ utilization of official co-operations or doctoral colleges

Get in touch with doctoral candidates at the university in order to

- _ obtain insider information
- _ exchange informal insights about the doctoral process
- _ obtain further networking opportunities



Making contacts

- _ use the network of university supervisors to be recommended directly
- _ common application to a university professor
 - _ principle is based on a peer recommendation
- _ letter of recommendation from the academic supervisor at the university

Our Tip:



in case of a rejection by the university professor, ask for an alternative supervisor from the existing network
