What do I need to bring?

Academic requirements

Successfully completed **Bachelor's degree in the field** of Nursing (min. 180 ECTS)

Additional requirements

Practical experience in different areas of health care (at least 2,500 hours, also possible during bachelor) or professional recognition in Germany.

Proficiency in English, proven by either

- _ TOEFL minimum 90
- _ IELTS 6.5 or above

Basic language skills in German, proven by official test score documents (e.g. Goethe, telc, ÖSD) - **minimum level A2** according to the CEFR (The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

You register in our online portal **Primuss** and fill in the application form with your personal details. You also upload all required documents in the portal and send your application directly to Hof University.
