ABOUT THE UREPP PROJECT

The Uganda Refugee Employment Promotion Project (UREPP) aims to improve employment prospects for young people – particularly refugees and women – through practice-oriented vocational training.

At its core are short-term, labour market-oriented training programmes that are closely aligned with the needs of local businesses and designed to facilitate the transition into employment or self-employment.

OBJECTIVE OF THE THESIS

The objective of the thesis is to evaluate the outcomes of UREPP Phase 1 and Phase 2, with a particular focus on:

- the employment situation of graduates after completing the short-term training programmes
- sustainable labour market integration (employment, self-employment, income development)
- participation and employment opportunities for women
- the integration of refugees into training and the labour market

A central component is the tracking of participants from the first and second project phases and the analysis of their individual employment trajectories. The results will serve as a key basis for the final project evaluation of bbw gGmbH vis-à-vis the funding donor.
