

Internships

A six-month internship in a company either in Germany or India is mandatory.

The GIMS program is highly supported by the industry. Many companies offer exclusive internships to GIMS students; however, each student is free to find and choose a company of his or her choice.

The international career service at Hof University offers excellent workshops regarding ‘Searching for Jobs in Germany’ or ‘CV writing’. Further workshops and trainings are offered exclusively to GIMS students, as well.

Internships in Germany are usually paid, with salaries ranging between 350 EUR – 1.200 EUR.
